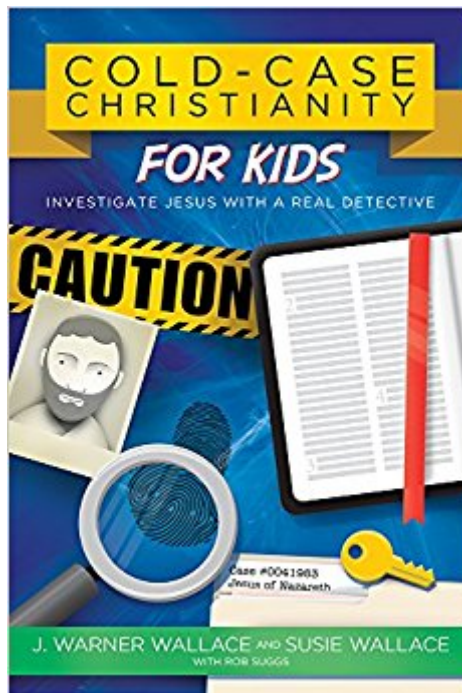

Cold-Case Christianity for Kids includes many illustrations I've drawn for kids, and is supported by an interactive website that allows kids to download chapter activities and "case note" fill-in sheets. When these are successfully completed and assembled in an "Academy Notebook," readers will be qualified to earn a Cold-Case Academy "Certificate of Merit." Plus, Cold-Case Christianity for Kids follows the same chapter sequence as my adult book, Cold-Case Christianity, so parents and children can discuss and explore the evidence together, chapter by chapter.

The book came in the mail, and as usual my son Thomas pounced on the box to see what was in it. Cool! was the immediate response. Thomas is 14 and this review consists of his comments to me about what he read. It took him a couple of days to read, which is about 4 hours total because he's empowered through it to use his terms. Thomas's comments after reading through Cold-Case Christianity for Kids.

1. The graphics were good, helpful, and well-done.
2. All the captions from the figures are quotes from the text emphasizing the main points.
3. The logical arguments were presented in a way that ANYONE would understand them.
4. The book used real-world examples, which helped.
5. There are some fill-in-the-blank portions for kids to write in answers from their reading.
6. We make conclusions everyday using logic. This book uses this same logic to show that God is the most reasonable conclusion to a) a universe that began to exist, b) a finely-tuned universe, c) big moral truths, and d) information in DNA. (page 50).
7. It was a nice read.
8. It will entertain kids, but it would be best if an adult read it with them. As a parent, I was very

pleased that this book sparked some good conversations. But this happens a lot in our house with my involvement with Ratio Christi. **But if conversations on the truthfulness of Christianity are rare in your house, get this book. **Read through it with your kids. It will start your whole family on the path to exploring God with your mind as well as your heart. My 9 year old as been questioning his faith and this answered so many of his questions and then some. Love the format of the mystery. At times it seemed he was more interested in the skateboard mystery, but by the end I realized he had really absorbed the apologetics. Didn't really care much about the printouts and video links, but some others might really enjoy those. I will say, the website is not very easy to maneuver. There's no place to easily print off all the activity sheets at once, so you have to go through each chapters webpage. Clunky.

We enjoyed the way the book was structured with the detective lessons and the way thinking critically about the claims about Jesus was woven in. It not only taught my kids to defend the faith but also helped them to learn to think critically. Highly recommended!

I was looking for a resource to teach an apologetic class to kids in 6th grade and beyond. It's easy to read and offers online resources to use in a classroom situation. Wallace's explanations are clear and he even inserts a character who is a skeptic who asks the kind of questions a skeptic would ask. I enjoyed it and hope to use it to instill reasons to have faith in God and His son, Jesus Christ.

My girls (5 & 8) love kid Apologetics books. We have gone through Lee Stroebel's Case for Christ for Kids and Case for Grace for Kids. I opened Cold Case for Kids tonight for the first time with my girls, and they are already hooked. We had to stop right after the intro, and they were begging for more. The book is very captivating for kids with the same substance of its adult counterpart.

I read the adult version of this book a couple of years ago and God's Crime Scene this past year. I highly recommend this book to parents as a primer for apologetics with their families. I love the approach that J. Warner Wallace (highly successful cold case detective) takes in presenting apologetics through the eyes of a detective, and one that used to be an atheist but came to believe in Jesus Christ through the evidence. This is a very fun and easy read. Excellent to read through with your kids! It also has an accompanying website with exercises and activities. Look for God's Crime scene for Kids that is in the works. I'll be reading and reviewing that book as soon as it comes out.

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
