This book delivers what it promised: complete detail of each one of the twenty-two Hebrew letters':1. Design, with historic commentary citing;2. Numeric equivalent, with examples and good intro toward Gematria;3. Meanings, with excellent TaNaK-based citings. It doesn't highlight the alef-beis sounds; I think the author's target audience was NOT a graphologically-curious Gentile.
