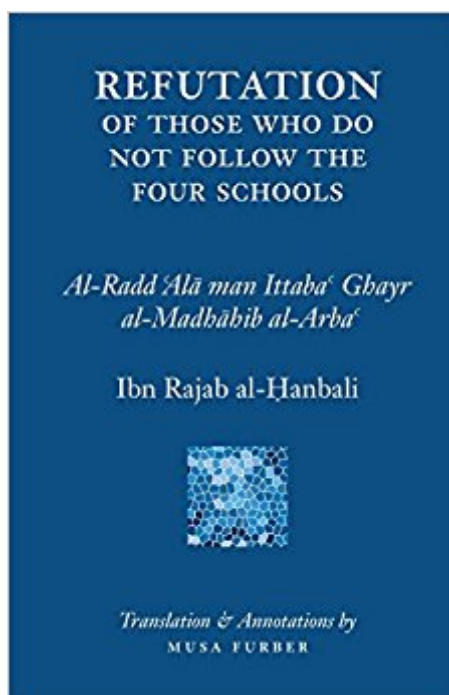


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Ibn Rajab's Refutation Of Those Who Do Not Follow The Four Schools
