The loop as described here is relatively short but offers quite a bit of diversity, pleasant canyon with oak-studded canopy, steep climbs, fast open descents, and moderately technical singletrack. For long-distance riders, you can add plenty of mileage by incorporating Roacky Peak Road, Johnson Motorway, and Hummingbird Trail.
