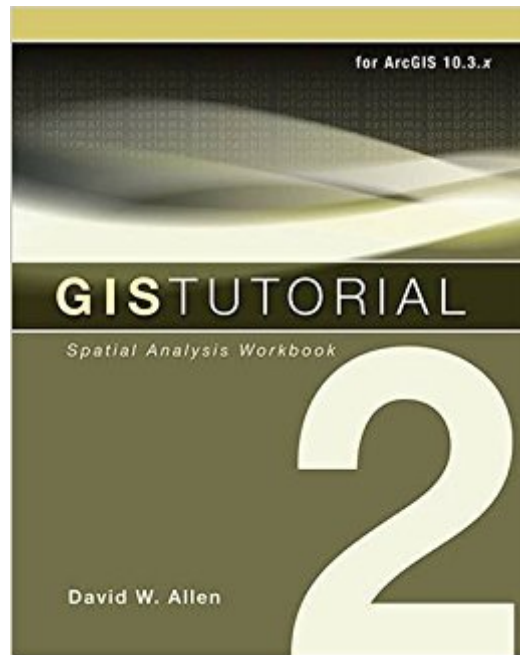


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# GIS Tutorial 2: Spatial Analysis Workbook (GIS Tutorials)
