His book on the teaching of writing, *Writing at the Threshold*, was a longtime bestseller of the National Council of Teachers of English (NCTE). Other books by Weinstein include *Grammar for the Soul*, *Grammar Moves* (with his colleague Thomas Finn), and *Writing Doesn't Have to Be Lonely*. Plays by Weinstein have been performed in Boston, Dallas, and New York."
