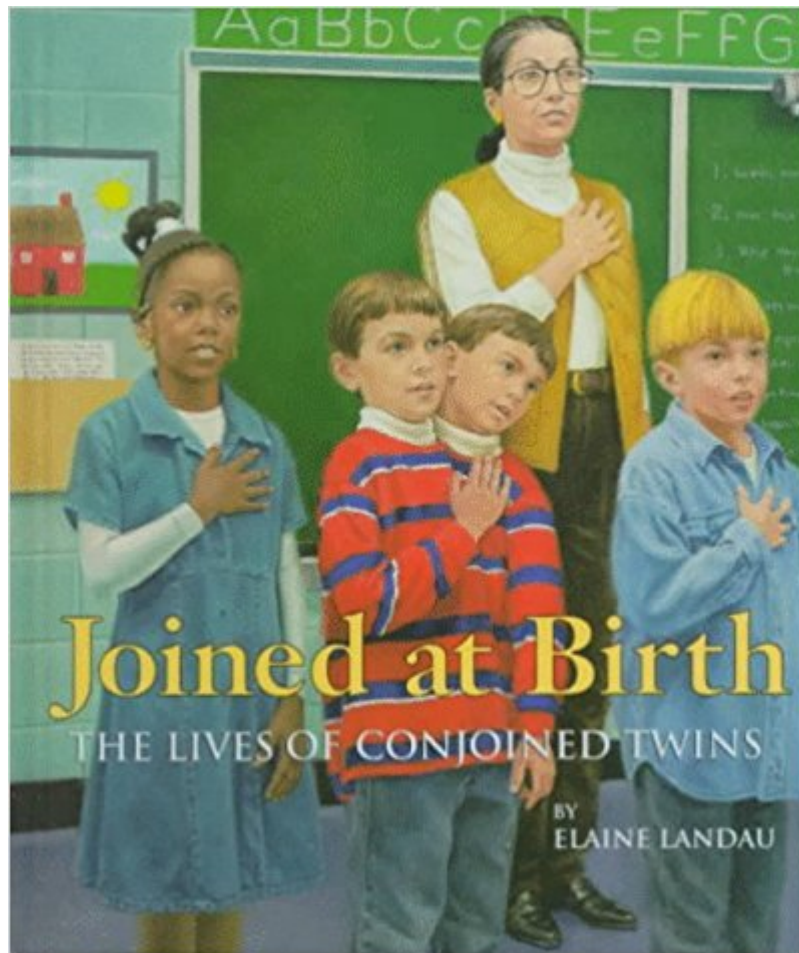

Chapters provide historical and modern examples of conjoined twins (Joined at Birth) and dwarfism (Short Stature); medical causes and treatments of the conditions; and questions, concerns, and challenges faced by young people and adults living with these differences. Special terms are printed in bold type and most are explained within the text. While the books focus on the differences, Landau adeptly describes how these individuals are like everyone else. I came upon this book, perhaps with some misconceptions prior to ordering it. The books quality is dated and it shows. For some reason I was expecting it to be illustrated and it is not. Also I thought it was for children but find its content for older kids.

My son had never before seen a conjoined person, and therefore I did my best to keep this book away from him as it would serve no useful purpose for him to read it. He found it anyway at his school library, and since then he's been curious about meeting a conjoined person. Not well aware of this issue myself, I did some research and found that the vast majority of conjoined twins die from complications at a very young age, much younger than the boy(s) in this story. That said, this book serves little purpose other than confusing children and overplaying a rare medical issue.

[SPOILER ALERT!]...one of the main characters has two heads. I don't know if you have a problem with that, but I sure as hell do.

This book is not very good because the end is very unsettling, the intro is in the middle of the book, and really doesn't talk about the overall population of conjoined twins. I wouldn't recommend this book to most people.
