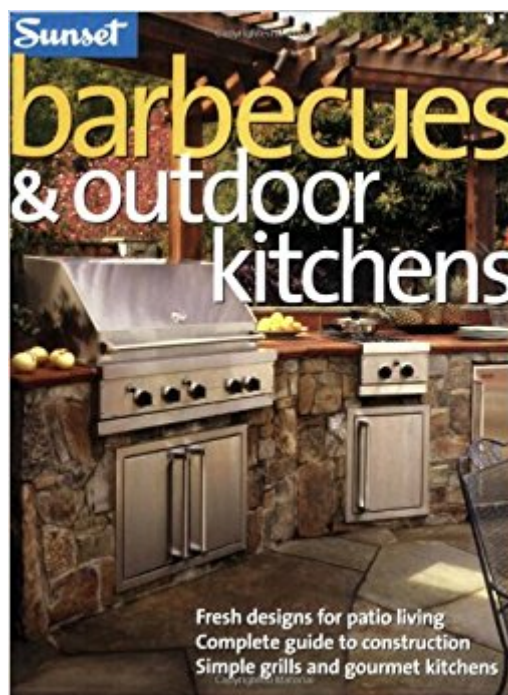

the book has a lot of ideas and design about outdoor kitchen. the instructions seem to be mostly picture and the picture shows the project partially built. there is no picture showing step by step instructions on how to build the project. the book also have you jumping around to different pages on how to complete the project. it's kind of confusing.

Ordering the book was extremely easy and it was very informative for visioning an outdoor kitchen. It was helpful in determining what I wanted in my space.

While this was a bit more technical than a picture book of design ideas, it offered little in the way of technical considerations as you design and build your barbeque. I'm a fairly experienced builder, so perhaps it was just a bit too basic. If you intend to build your own structure, you'll need to do your

own research into the rough measurements required for access doors, drawers, grills, tanks, burners, etc. You'll also need to do your own research into the plumbing products required for propane or natural gas devices. Likewise, look elsewhere for design considerations for electrical safety, pipe routes, and distance between tanks and burners. In short - this is book that offers some basic design considerations, but not sufficient technical information to fully complete a project.

Not enough detail, but it is a great overview of all aspects. I am interested in steel stud construction and it was very light in detail there.

We use 24" footings to support 2 story homes here in Houston. It is ridiculous to recommend such overengineering for a 30 to 36" table top in a backyard kitchen. Designs were attractive. I showed the plans to a specialist and his comment was that you could get pre-built units with metal framing in stores (at a very high cost as compared to the books DIY). Good step-by-step illustrations.

An old magazine but exactly what I wanted. Now to build a grill.....

My husband loved it and got him motivated for a new home project. He said it was just the right amount of instruction!

I was looking for a detailed description of how to build an outdoor kitchen from metal studs. This was not useful for that. The 1 star is for some useful info that I got from reading the book.
