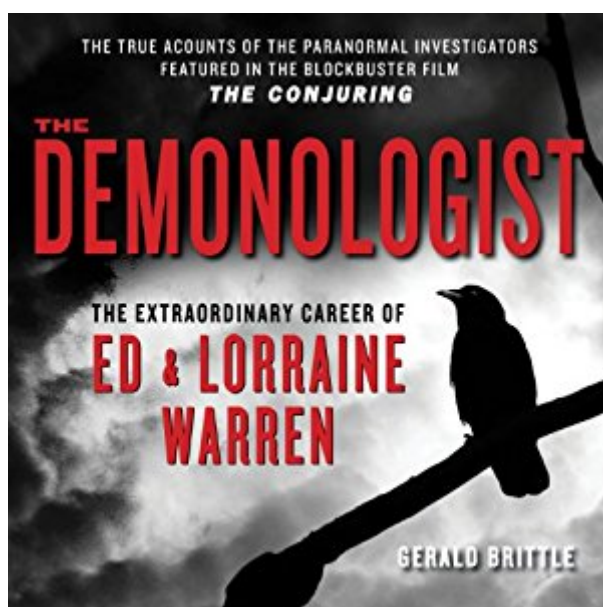

I've always been interested in the occult and The Amityville Horror was one of the first scary books I'd ever read. So, what better than to read about the occult from the very people that studied Amityville? The book is definitely interesting, but it's kind of a boring read. You would think, with all

the research they've done that this book would be a real page turner but, alas no. I still enjoyed it, it just took me awhile to get through.

This book takes a clear eyed and calm look at the strange career of the Wardens and what information they have found to be true about the spirit world. Almost clinical in discussion and with documentation to back up their experiences, you will want to learn more about the Warrens and their dedication to educating about the public about demons, devils, and ghosts.

Currently, I'm doing research on modern paranormal research and where current society places this interest. With all the developing reality TV shows like Ghost Hunters, Ghost Adventures, Celebrity Ghost Stories and Paranormal State, the interest in what happens in the after life is becoming more and more obvious. Regardless if you are deeply religious, atheist, or constantly wavering between both extremes, death is what each human being will experience. I enjoyed reading the book even though some of the information was a little difficult to swallow. It was well written and easy to read.
