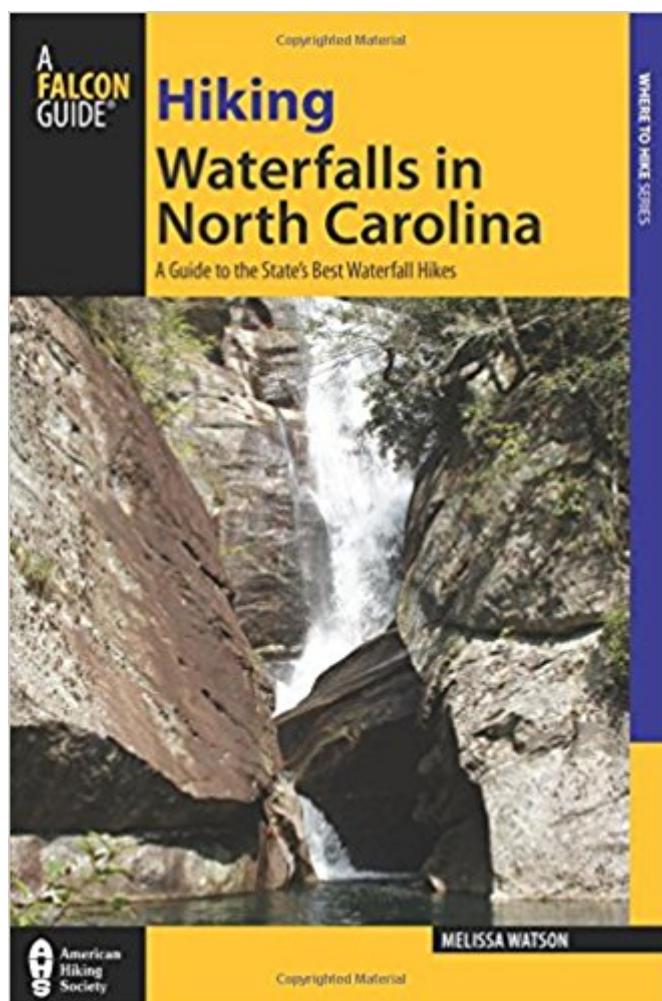


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Hiking Waterfalls In North Carolina: A Guide To The State's Best Waterfall Hikes
