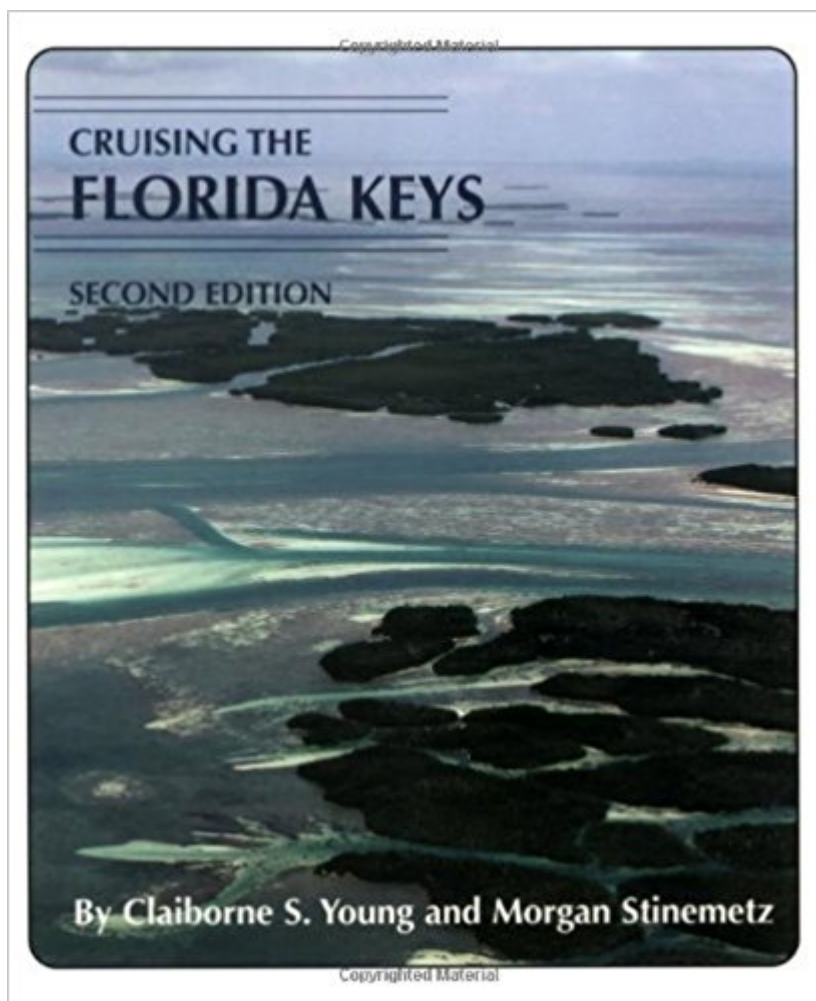

It provides way too much information for short term cruisers and a lot of it is quite dated. While I enjoy Mr. Young's writing style, this book is hard to use when cruising down to the Keys.
