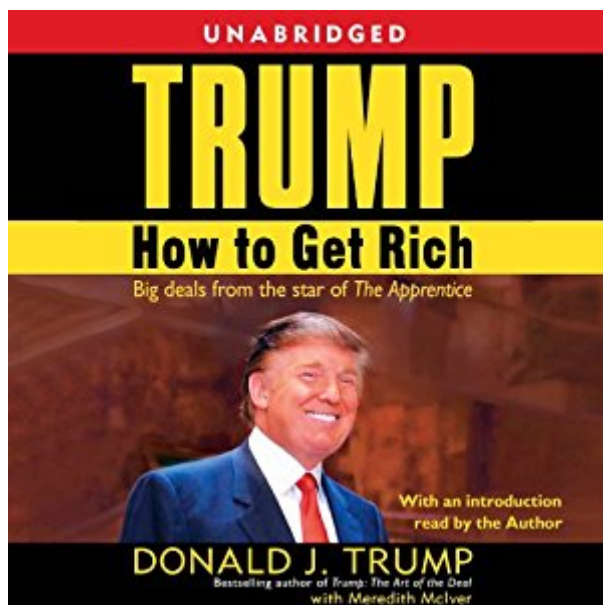

Donald Trump, more than being a businessman, is an entertainer and a very capable one-product marketing machine, where the product is Donald Trump. This book offers some common sense business advice on how to deal with employees, competitors etc. but is completely lacking any specifics on his real estate deals. The only thing which I found mildly entertaining is his constant bragging in regards to his achievements, his friends in high places (Melanie Griffith, Regis Philbin) and his hate for doctors. The only memorable advice was in regards to marriage where "The Donald" states: "Get a prenuptial agreement".
