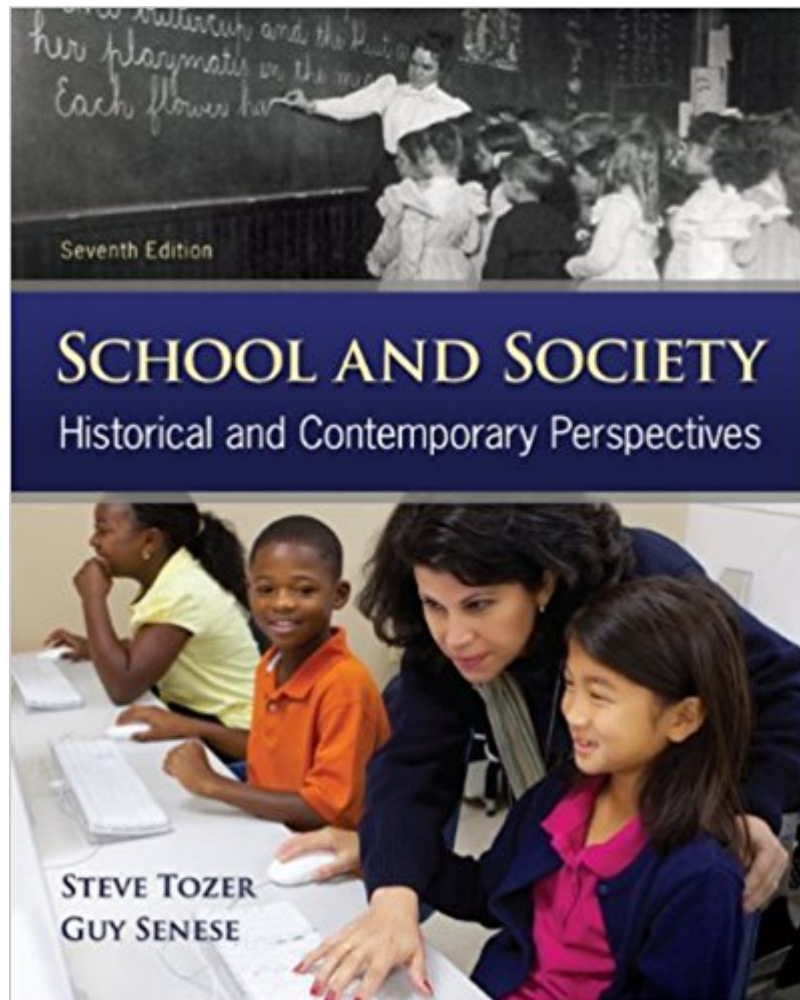

He received his Ph.D. in Education at The University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign. He taught school in Champaign Illinois, and at the Rough Rock Demonstration School on the Navajo Reservation in Arizona. Paul C. Violas (deceased) was formerly Professor of History of Education in The College of Education at The University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign. He has received the College of Education Award for Excellence in Undergraduate Teaching, The College Career Teaching Award, and The University's Luckman Award for Undergraduate Teaching. Professor Violas received his Ed.D. degree at The University of Rochester. He taught secondary school social studies for six years. He has been a regular contributor to journals. Steven E. Tozer is Professor of Philosophy of Education at The University of Illinois, Chicago. At The University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign, he was Head of The Department of Curriculum and Instruction from 1990 to 1994. He has been Chair of The Committee on Academic Standards and Accreditation in The American Education Studies Association and a member of The Board of Examiners for The National Council on Accreditation of Teacher Education. He has written regularly for numerous journals. Professor Tozer completed his Ph.D. at The University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign. He has taught at the early childhood, elementary and secondary levels.

Did I need this book to learn about the Jeffersonian Ideal, or Horace Mann? Absolutely not, there are countless pages published on these topics that would have cost significantly less. Wishing professors would wise up and quit wasting our money.

This book was required for an education course. It was delivered to me in the worst condition! Pages falling out of the book, you can tell water was spilled on it at some point because the pages are all dried up and wrinkled, and all of the highlighting, writing, and circling is a huge distraction. Books in

this condition should not be distributed to renters or buyers!

I got the book, but there were multiple pages missing (the first seven pages of the first chapter, etc) and it was really beat up. Just hoping I can get enough of the content from it to not fail my class. I bought it as "Used- Acceptable" which CLEARLY states all pages must be intact, with only aesthetic issues like dents, tears, etc. Disappointed.

The chapters are divided into two sections. The first sections are very informative and engaging. They detail the history of social injustice throughout the past of American education. The second half of each chapter is a variety of boring overly detail biographies.
