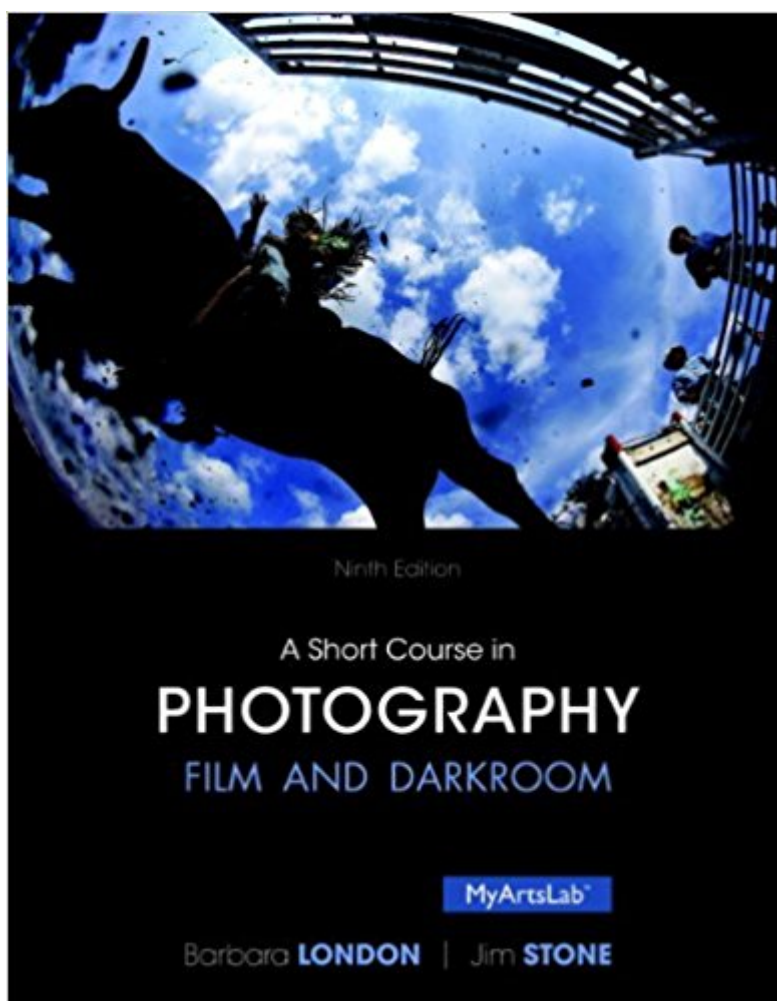

It was sold as a Kindle Ebook on the first page, then on the actual order page, it is described as an "Etextbook". Save yourself the trouble and just find a text copy used.
