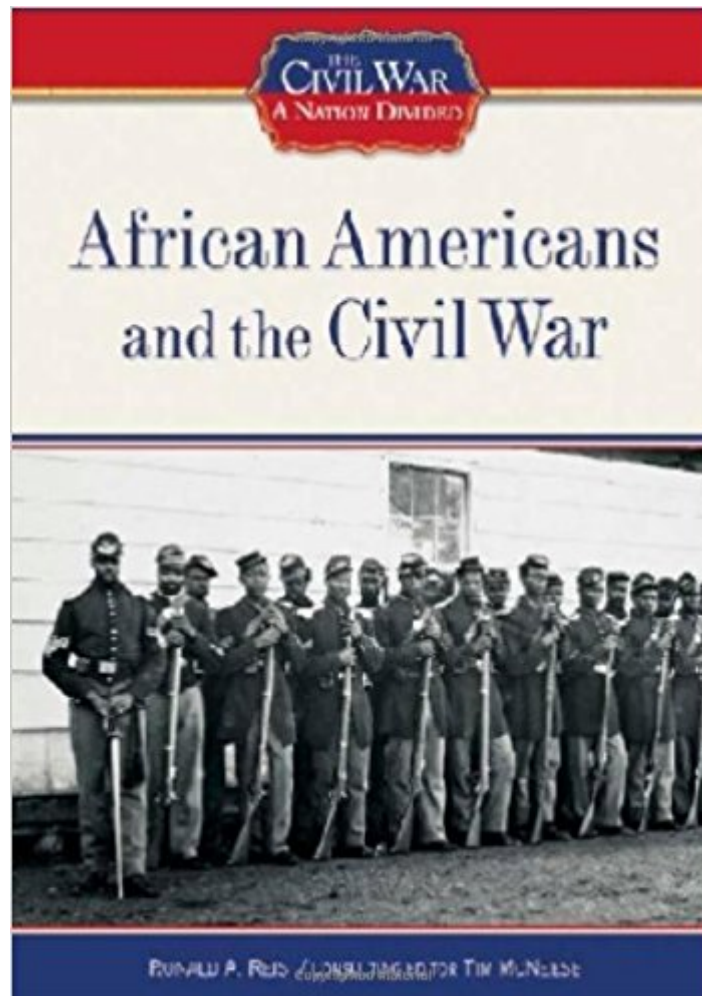




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African Americans And The Civil War (Civil War: A Nation Divided (Library))

I was surprised in learning about Contraband, the main reason for the war, why did the Confederate states support slavery and why did the Union states not support slavery?.
