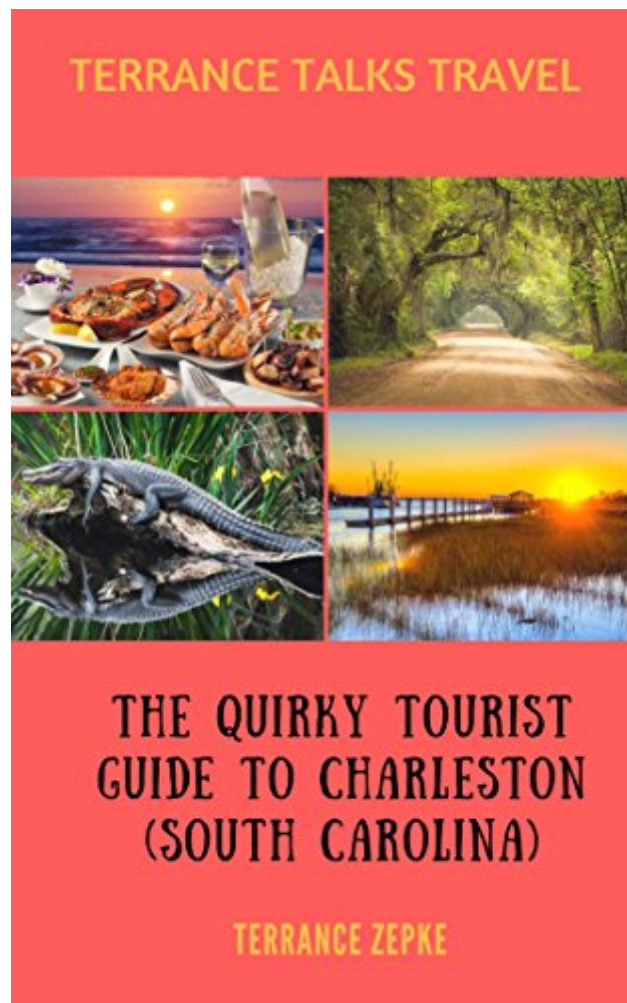

Moving on from this book's content and on to the discussion of the cover design, the cover shows four images of the area in and around Charleston. Personally, I would have liked the cover more if there was a person or people on the cover considering that the book centers on traveling that is, in turn, closely connected with tourism. Now moving on to what is inside The Quirky Tourist Guide To Charleston. The overall editing is clean and easy to read, because this author correctly adheres to grammar rules, for example. The writer's tone is also approachable and chatty, personally reminding me of being with a tour guide in Charleston.
