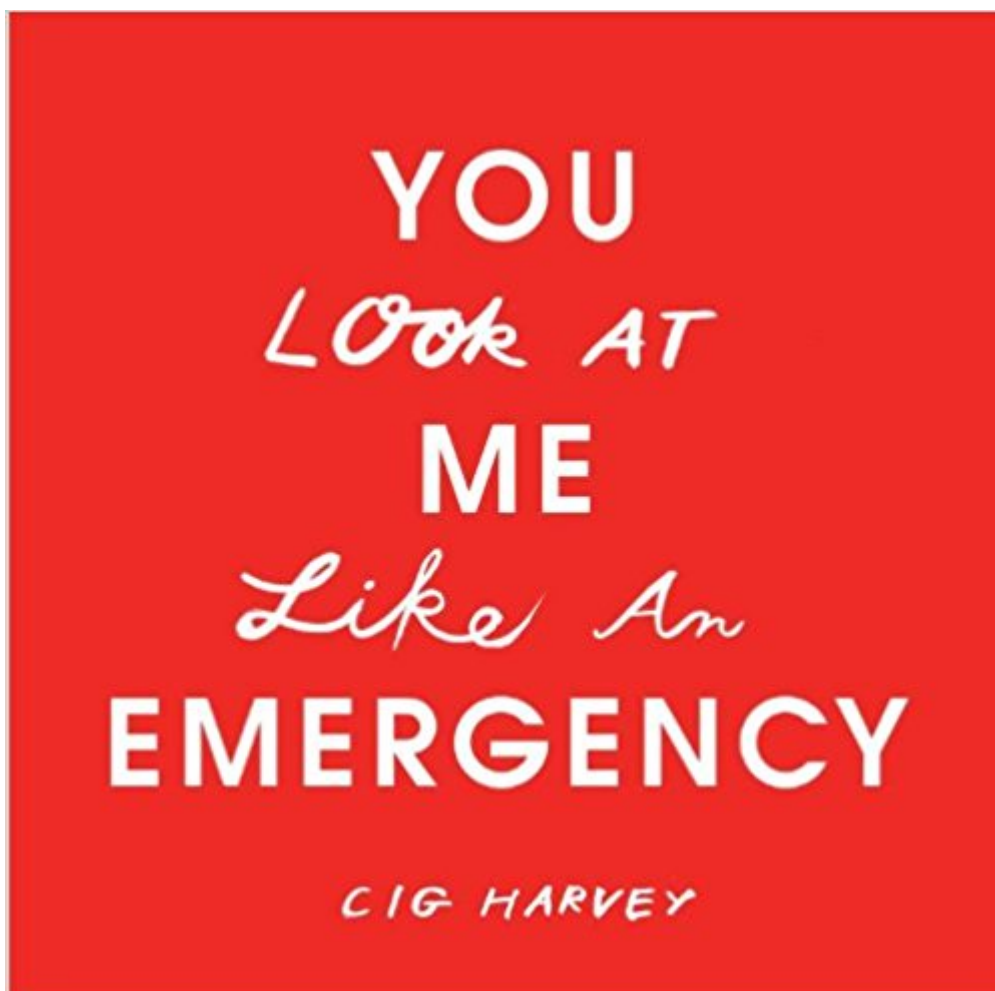

Cig Harvey's photographs are intertwined with a rich narrative and autobiography. Since the age of thirteen, she has found herself captivated by and single-mindedly committed to the medium of

photography as a way to tell stories. Cig's photographs have been exhibited widely and are in the permanent collection of major museums including The Museum of Fine Arts, Houston and the International Museum of Photography, George Eastman House, Rochester, NY. She was a finalist for the prestigious BMW prize at Paris Photo in 2010 and has her first solo museum show at The Stenersen Museum, Oslo, in the spring of 2012. Cig's devotion to visual storytelling has led to innovative international campaigns and features with New York Magazine, Harpers Bazaar, Kate Spade, Bloomingdales and a celebrated year of covers with Maine Magazine. In addition to teaching workshops and regularly giving talks on her work and process at universities and institutions around the world, Cig is a full-time Assistant Professor of Photography at the Art Institute of Boston at Lesley University.
