

This is my first time buying and reading a book on 's Kindle app, and every time I need to access this book it's been a frustrating experience. Clicking to go on to the next page will take you back to the last chapter. It will randomly resize itself so passages aren't in the same place. And, even though I've had the book for a few months now, it will take a while to load between pages and navigation. Maybe it's just that the Kindle app doesn't work all that well with Windows 10, but I regret not buying the paperback version of this book as then I would have given it five stars. If you like using Kindle, by all means, go ahead. But if you're a e-book scrub like me, you're better off with the print version.
