

I really enjoyed this story and felt invested in all of the characters. I know an author has a special gift for writing about love and loss and heartbreak when I feel physical pain while reading certain scenes. The painful journey was worth the rewarding HEA! One caveat, I really wish authors would do their research when writing about sports! College football games in every division are almost exclusively held on Saturdays, the regular season ends at the end of November, and championship games for division 2&3 are in December, not February. Of course, the division 1 championship is held in early January, but there us no way that Jaxon played for a division 1 team because the entire sequence of events would be implausible in that case. Luckily, the story and writing are both well executed so even this diehard college football fan could ignore the lack of collegiate football knowledge.

This is another book that won me over quickly once I got my hand on the sample. If ever there was a main character that I immediately felt a kinship with, Emerson is it. She reminds me so much of myself, it was like Kimberly Lauren had been hanging out with me during my twenties and wrote a

book with me as the main character. The one difference between Emerson and myself is that Emerson grew up, let someone in and took chances and it was really nice to see.
