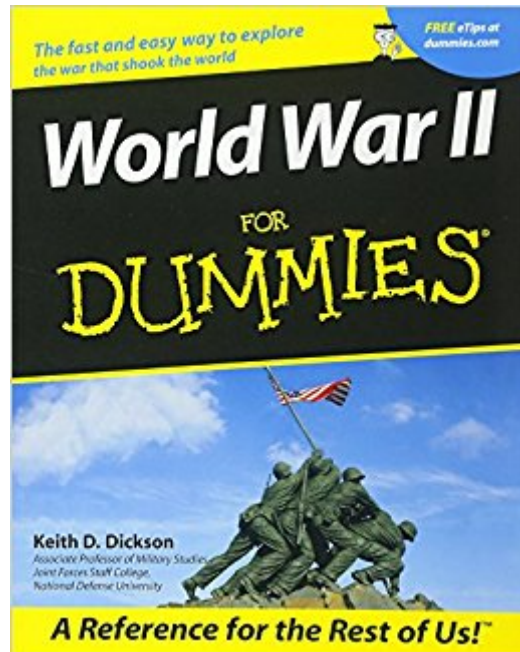

However if you're looking for a comprehensive volume on the war, this isn't it. So far the WWII expert in me has been really impressed with what is included. It can spark an interest in someone who wants to know more about this important conflict.

Great summary which really opens your eyes!! But the maps are not very clear - it's difficult or impossible to see the boundaries of land and sea. This may seem insignificant, but you need the maps to understand the text. Overall, though, this is a great way to get the highlights of this incredibly complicated part of history.

Keith Dickson did a superb job writing this book. Information is presented simply and in such an interesting way it's captivating. I've always known a bit about the ETO (European Theater Ops), but not much at all about the PTO (Pacific Theater Ops). I found the opening chapter to the book especially helpful, as it explained why

certain countries aligned the way they did before the war started. It also does a good job setting up the Japanese Empire's goals and directives, which I think gets ignored quite a bit in history classes. If you're a casual student of military history who wants a good foundation for deeper study, this is a great book (especially for high school students who want a good, easy read without getting bogged down in incredible detail). In addition, the maps are simplistic and easy to understand re: army movements.
