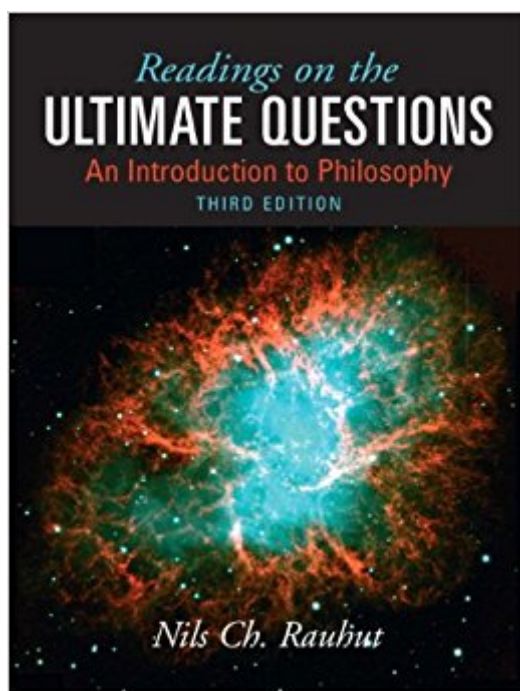


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# Readings On Ultimate Questions: An Introduction To Philosophy (3rd Edition)
