put in larger containers, an extensive plant glossary, and recipes using each of the container designs. I also liked "Grow Vegetables in Pots" which is a DK Publishing title. This book also includes herbs and fruit-bearing trees and bushes for container planting, plus a good section on pests and diseases.
