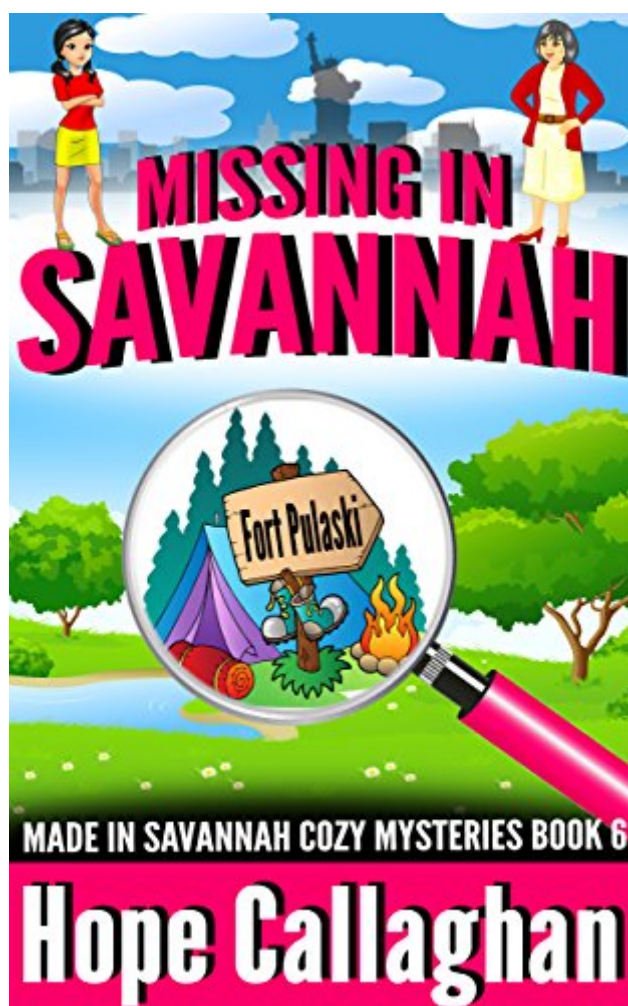


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Missing In Savannah: A Made In Savannah Cozy Mystery (Made In Savannah Cozy Mysteries Series Book 6)
