

I recently took my test and passed with an 89. I did a crash study course three weeks before plus

the years of experience I have. I felt like it prepared me for the test wording, much better than the mic one. I felt that the practice tests focused on math and other things that the actual test did not. That being said I only did about five practice tests. I passed them all before the test. Sat down to the test and felt like I would fail it while I was taking it. But I passed. So something in my study time helped. I also feel like the last chapter in the book should be first. Some of the terminology used in the first three sections isn't explained until the last chapter. And that would have made it easier to know the physics before all the other stuff.

This is a great review tool! I used this along with the MIC book to get my credits. After I had those I didn't really use the MIC anymore. I really heavily studied this book and the online questions for a month and passed! Background: 4 years RT with no CT schooling, but one year of being cross trained at my job in CT. (Pediatric).

I can't really complain about this resource, but at the same time, I can't praise it either. Pros: Condensed information about CT instrumentation, procedures, anatomy and quality control. Lots of test questions in book, and online (which is how you will be tested with the ARRT), and answers provided. You will pass with just this book. Cons: While it has anatomy, it does not have enough to feel confident, you would need to find a supplemental source, as the ARRT had images of slices where I had no clue what I was really looking at. No pathology, while not required for the exam, it is a helpful aspect when providing services to patients. The procedures in scanning are divided into sections, but to find windowing levels, preferred injection rates, or delays, it gets frustrating trying to dig through the text for that to put on a straight forward cheat sheet to review on the go. You will pass, but it does not mean you will get respect from more knowledgeable techs who expect more from others, but that depends highly on workplace culture.

I bought this book to study for my CT registry and I'm so glad that I did! I only used this book and the CT basics course through the ASRT and I felt really prepared for the exam. This book definitely helped me pass!

Do not listen to the negative reviews! I am a nuclear medicine tech. I trained in CT for 3 months part time back in March. I bought this book. Reviewed it for a week. Took the practice tests over and over again until I didn't miss any. And just passed (8/9/14) the ARRT exam with an 88%. This book is easy to read, in depth, and has a great review of most of the

Anatomy I encountered on the exam. Best \$45 I have ever spent.

I just took the registry Monday and I panicked the entire time because the test was nothing like the practice tests/questions in this book. I did not go to CT school so I can't fully say that this book didn't help in some way, but you definitely should get other sources to study from. I got a 77% on the test and I was genuinely shocked because I was waiting to see a 50%.

I studied this Mosby's book and Lois E. Roman Computed Tomography for Technologist book. I recommend reading Lois E. Romans book first front to cover "The blue book" Great book to begin with explains stuff very well . Then read Mosby's Exam Review front to cover. Then log in and do the practice test they offer online all 650 questions and the exam review questions in the back of the book. The Anatomy in both of these books is adequate, but buy a cross sectional anatomy book also just for additonal studying.Although I will say the Mosby's book is a big reason why I passed the CT exam great book. I got a 90!

I just passed my CT registry test by just studying this book. Before I bought this book I read all the comments that people wrote about it, so I decided to give it a try with only three weeks of studying. I would recommend this book to any one who really want to learn and pass there CT registry. This is the only book you need
